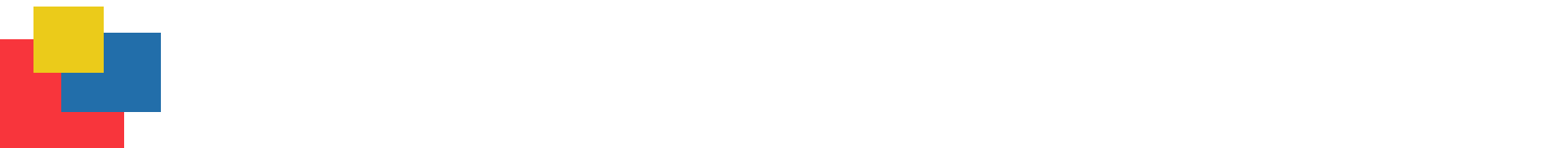
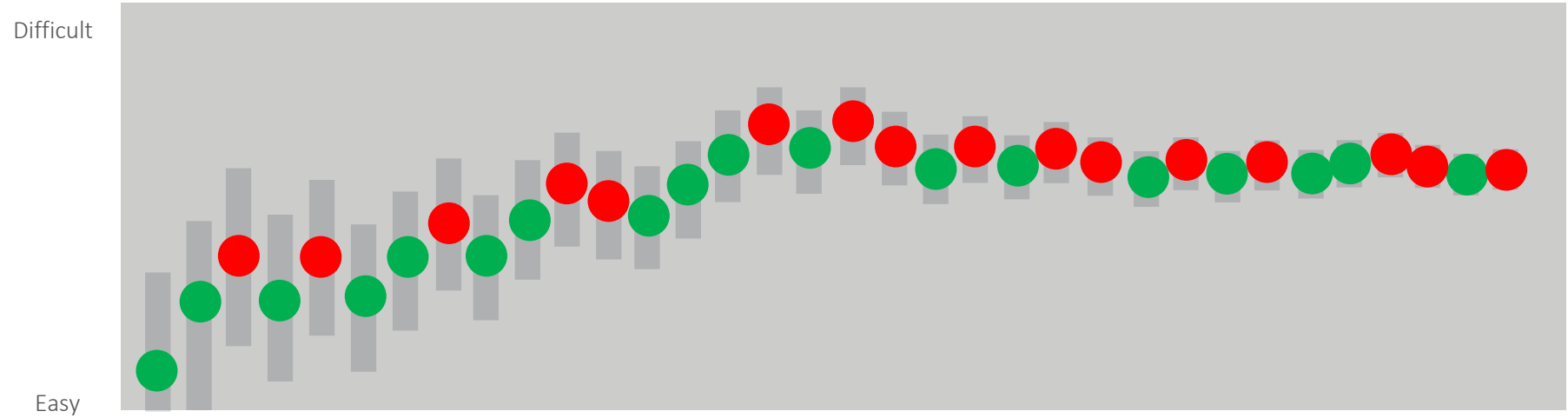
- All students enrolled in grades K-2, including:

Design – Computer Adaptive Test



Items answered by student


● Correct Response ● Incorrect Response



Data from Prior PM administration



If data is available from the prior PM, it will be used to deliver the first item to a student based on that student's previous performance.

- For example, If a student was performing above grade level at PM3 last year, the algorithm would take that into account when selecting the first item for the student. The system will choose an item around that same level to begin the assessment, then the system would continue to adjust based on whether the student gets that item correct or incorrect.
 - If the system has no data for the student (i.e., new to the state), they will receive a mid-range item to begin the test.
 - All test content is on grade-level and will adhere to the blueprint for all students

- Items test skills in four broad Mathematics domains
- 34 items
- 30 minutes average test length
- Kindergarten, 1, and 2 in Florida
- Headphones are required
- Scratch paper is required

- Numbers and Operations
- Algebra
- Geometry & Measurement
- Data Analysis, Statistics & Probability

May 1 to May 31, 2024

Who is Tested?



BEST Writing: All students enrolled in Grades 4-8

FAST ELA & Math: All students enrolled in Grades 3 – 8.

BEST EOC's: All students enrolled in Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and Civics

Science: All students enrolled in Grades 5 and 8.



Testing Schedule and More

- Students will be allowed to work in their BEST and FAST assessments until the end of the school day (3:05 p.m.).
- Students who need to continue working after 12:00 p.m. will be provided with lunch. These students will continue testing after their lunch is over.
- Snacks will be provided for all testing students.
- Calculators are built-in in the testing platform.
- Make-up testing: Students who are absent or late (after 9:00 a.m.) on testing day will be provided a make-up opportunity

Testing Tips for Parents




- Early bedtime: 9-10 hours of sleep for a fresh mind.
- Review testing strategies with your child: Read passages and questions carefully, review each answer option before making a choice, use the strategies learned in class (underlining, making notations, checking).
- Breakfast: High protein content foods, such as eggs, cheese, yogurt, oatmeal, granola bars. No foods with high sugar content to avoid energy crash during testing.
- Make sure your child has all necessary materials needed for testing day.
- Stay positive and calm.
- Practice relaxing breathing exercises. See example below.
