Students are expected to **read 20 minutes a day**, keep track of the books they read on the "<u>First Grade Summer Reading Log</u>", and complete the "<u>First Grade Summer Reading Bingo</u>". Then, select a book from the list below and complete a **book report**.

Book Report Instructions:

- 1. Make either a **mini-poster** (8.5"x11") about the book or a **paper bag puppet** of the main character. Be creative! You can use paint, marker, construction paper, yarn, ribbon, etc.
- 2. On a sheet of lined paper, write **your name**, the **book title** (underlined), and the **author's name**. Write a **summary** of the story (beginning, middle, and end). Please write neatly and in complete sentences. Glue the summary to the back of your poster or puppet.
- 3. The <u>reading log</u>, <u>book report</u>, and <u>bingo board</u> are due the **FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL**. Please place them in a Ziploc bag with your child's name. (You may also bring them to the "Meet and Greet".)
